TWINKLE, TWINKLE TRAFFIC LIGHT

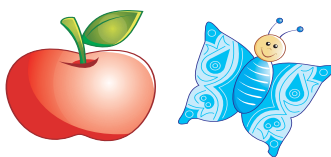
Twinkle, twinkle traffic light

DAD'S BIKE

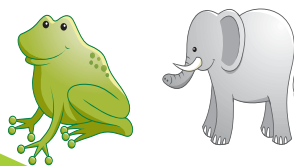
My dad has a bike
